We give the following guarantee with our machines instead of the guarantee implied by statute, or otherwise, as to the quality or fitness for the purpose of cycling of goods supplied by us; any such implied guarantee being in all cases excluded. In the case of machines which have been used for "hiring out" purposes no guarantee of any kind is given or is to be implied.

AND WE HEREBY WARRANT, subject to the conditions mentioned below, that all precautions which are usual and reasonable have been taken by us to secure excellence of materials and workmanship; but this guarantee is to extend and be in force for one year only from date of purchase; and the purchaser shall not be entitled to claim any damages whatever, save compensation for injury to the cycle. We undertake, subject to the conditions mentioned below, to make good at any time within a year any defects in these respects in our cycles. This guarantee does not apply to the Tyres, or to defects caused by wear and tear, misuse or neglect.

TYRES are guaranteed in accordance with the maker's guarantee, which is as follows:

Roadster Cycle Tyres of standard sizes made and sold for use in Great Britain which fail by reason of bad workmanship or defective materials within a period of 12 months from the date upon which such tyres were issued by the company, will be replaced or repaired by the company at a charge proportionate to the wear which the tyres have given. Wood Rims are limited to the guarantee of the manufacturer.

This undertaking lasts for 12 months from the date upon which such tyres are issued by the company, after which period no claim can be entertained by the company.

Replacements under Guarantee.—If a defective part should be found in any of our machines it must be sent to us by passenger train, carriage paid, and accompanied by an intimation from the sender that he desires to have it repaired free of charge under our guarantee; and he must also furnish us at the same time with the number of the machine, the name of the agent from whom he purchased, and the date of the purchase. Failing compliance with the above, no notice will be taken of anything which may arrive, but such article will lie here at the risk of senders.

We guarantee only those machines which are bought either direct from us or from one of our duly authorised agents, and under no other conditions.

The Term Agent is used in a complimentary sense only, and those firms whom we style our agents are not authorised to advertise, incur any debts, or transact any business whatsoever on our account, other than the sale of goods which they may purchase from us; nor are they authorised to give any warranty or to make any representation on our behalf other than those contained in the above guarantee.


